Call 9-1-1 Immediately for Sudden & Life Threatening Injury/Illness

Drug overdose	Gunshot wounds
Difficulty breathing	Convulsions/seizures
Constant chest pain	Allergic reaction
Drowning	New severe headache
Electrocution	Sudden intense pain
Choking	Diabetic emergency
Severe burns	Poisoning

Visit Your Nearest ER for Possible Medical Emergencies

Sudden dizziness, weakness or mental changes	Broken bones
Sudden blindness/vision changes	Severe allergic reaction

Call Triad for Non-Emergency Medical Problems - (502) 484-2117

Colds/flu	Mild vomiting/diarrhea
Earache	Mild-to-moderate asthma
Sore throat/cough	Seasonal allergies
Minor accidents	STDs
Minor sprains	Bladder infection
Minor cuts	Back pain
Fever	Rashes
