Drug overdose
Difficulty breathing
Constant chest pain
Drowning
Electrocution
Choking
Gunshot wounds
Convulsions/seizures
Allergic reaction
New severe headache
Sudden intense pain
Diabetic emergency

Severe burns Poisoning

## Visit Your Nearest ER for Possible Medical Emergencies

Sudden dizziness, weakness or mental changes
Sudden blindness/vision changes
